



Thank you for making Summer Camp and Athens, Georgia, your destination of choice for mid-Summer flyball racing. We are very excited to welcome many of you back for our fifth season of fun and to introduce to you first-time attendees Rabid Fire, That’s So Fetch, Two-Lane Highway and Woodlawn Woofers. They and our returning campers bring 47 teams from eight states to this outing. Officiating the games are Amy Brubaker, Ian Cuthbertson, Paul Ferlitto and Leerie Jenkins. Apprentice judge Joan Weesies from Gulfport, Florida, joins them, as well. Your host for the weekend is Double Dog Dare. Amanda Brown is our Regional Director.

Site and Site Conditions

Our camp site is The Classic Center at 300 North Thomas Street in Athens. We expect activity in the unloading zone to be heavy Friday afternoon as campers arrive with their gear. Someone will be there to assist you and to ask you to move your vehicle once your move-in is complete. Please help us cycle new arrivals in and out of this zone as smoothly as possible.

Before hauling your gear inside, take a moment to find a counselor who can direct you to your assigned bunk. We’ve made efforts to be fair and, where possible, to consider special requests in making assignments. All space is well air conditioned and capable of getting chilly. If you can’t do chilly, you’ll want to have some extra clothing. If you’ve requested power, we hope to have that available to you upon your arrival. Cost for power for the weekend is \$60 per drop.

Hours of Operation and Activities

Camp opens at 6:30 a.m. Saturday and 7 a.m. Sunday, with activities beginning at 8. Campers may arrive as early as 4 p.m. Friday to setup living quarters. To make certain our campers are safe in the waters this weekend, the Swim Test portion of our program gets underway Friday evening at 6 p.m. Spots are available in 5-minute intervals at \$5 apiece per lane. We have two rings of competition in which we will run 221 races throughout the weekend. One hundred nineteen of those are scheduled to take place Saturday. We have 1-hour lunch breaks scheduled after races

66 and 185 Saturday and Sunday, respectively. And, as at any camp, the fun doesn't stop at sundown. Our team of counselors have worked diligently on yet another post-racing game that will have you searching high and low Saturday evening.

FlyballGeek, Ring Assignment and Recording Issues

We will use Flyball Geek to indicate ring assignment and the teams racing, on deck and in the hole. Ring assignments will be made by the individuals at Ring Control, located in the gutter between the rings. Requests related to ring assignment and reports of scoring discrepancies should be directed to Ring Control.

From the Camper Suggestion Box . . .

Scoring – Last year we reduced bonus points for a clean sweep (no ties, no losses) to one-quarter point in response to past comments that the bonus was weighted too heavily in scoring. The bonus for a clean sweep remains at one-quarter point. Complete format and scoring information is available at the seed chart published in the regions' Yahoo groups and at the event.

Ring Designation – Both rings will be color coded at both ends to reduce confusion about ring assignments.

Building Temperature – We will maintain a consistent, cool temperature inside, so plan accordingly. We ask for your help in minimizing the amount of traffic directly into the unloading area, which opens directly into Grand Hall 8. Instead, try using the hallway exits to help minimize loss of cool air.

RV Pavilion Lighting – For your sleeping comfort, overhead lighting will be turned off at 10 p.m. at the RV Pavilion, as there were complaints last year that it was too light to sleep.
